PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

On June 26, 2007 HAZCO's Emergency Response Team was activated by the Vancouver Police Department to facilitate decommissioning of a large scale clandestine laboratory located at 765 Powell Street in Vancouver, BC. The laboratory had unique characteristics such as the masking of the facility's true purpose under the guise of a bio-diesel manufacturing operation and use of complex vacuum distillation equipment. These circumstances required that HAZCO utilize members of their Environmental Technologies division to assist with the dismantling of intricate, pressurized equipment heavily contaminated with glacial acetic acid. Aiding the Vancouver Police and Fire Departments in site inspections and development of work procedures, the project was completed on July 3rd, 2007.
