Project Name: Hagwilget Tank Removal/Install, Hagwilget, B.C.

Project Value: \$40,000
 Date Completed: Fall 1996

Project Description: The project involved the removal of underground and above ground storage tanks and the installation of an above ground fueling system. HAZCO was able to employ First Nation's earth moving equipment and labor.
