



## HAZCO OPENS EDMONTON WASTE TRANSFER STATION

**HAZCO Environmental Services Ltd.** is pleased to announce the approval of our Edmonton Hazardous Waste Transfer Station. This facility is the newest of four Hazardous Waste Transfer Stations located in Western Canada. The Facility was officially approved by Alberta Environment in August, 2004 and has recently begun accepting waste. The facility is approved to receive all non-hazardous and hazardous wastes excluding explosives, radioactive and bio-hazardous waste. There are containerized storage, bulk storage pads and a tank farm at the facility.

### ***Location***

The Facility is located at 12311 – 17<sup>th</sup> Street NE conveniently situated to provide effective industrial and oilfield waste service to **Northeastern Alberta, Northwestern Saskatchewan and the Northwest Territories.**

### ***Permit***

The Hazardous Waste Transfer Station is operating under Alberta Environment Approval Number 206356-00-00, dated August 6, 2004. This facility has a permitted storage capacity of 715 tonnes of Hazardous Waste or Hazardous Recyclables and an additional 600 tonnes for non-hazardous waste.

### ***Financial Security***

Financial security in the form of a performance bond has been posted with Alberta Environment for the decommissioning and reclamation of the Waste Transfer Facility.
