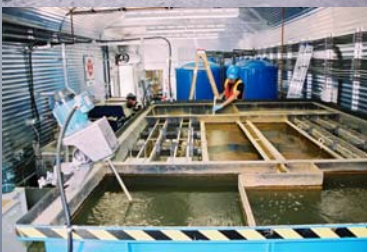

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Every British Columbia Home Depot has their waste removed on a quarterly basis
- Typically this includes 15 stores within a 1 to 1.5 month period
- HAZCO is responsible for the handling, packaging, transportation and disposal of all damaged, returned or written off hazardous waste products from the Home Depot. These products include latex and oil-based paints, pesticides, adhesives, corrosive and toxic cleaners, solvents, batteries, waste oil and absorbent materials. Each of the materials is lab-packed according to compatibility and Transportation of Dangerous Goods Class.
- HAZCO currently provides service to all 15 Home Depot outlets in British Columbia on a quarterly basis. Although the waste streams are consistent, the volumes are not. The Home Depot contract was awarded to HAZCO in 2002 and has been renewed twice.
